

**TOWN OF ROCKPORT  
YARD SALE PERMIT REGULATIONS**

These regulations were approved by the Board of Selectmen, under Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 100, Sections 1-10, and other applicable laws on May 21, 1981 and amended on August 4, 1992 and November 30, 1993 and advertised.

1. Permit requests must be submitted to the Board of Selectmen a minimum of one week in advance of proposed sale. Forms are available at the Selectmen's office.
2. A fee of \$5.00 is payable at the time of request.
3. All items for sale must originate from the home. In the case of yard sales conducted by charitable organizations or for the express purpose of raising funds for charitable or social organizations, or similar public purposes or organizations, items for sale shall be similar in nature and kind as would originate from a home.
4. A maximum of two sales per household per year is allowed.
5. Sign regulations:
  - A. One sign, approximately three square feet, is allowed on the premises.
  - B. Signs **may not** be nailed to trees. Non-compliance of this regulation will result in a \$200.00 fine.
  - C. Local sign by-laws apply, specifically: "No posting of signs on any property of the Town."
6. A copy of this permit will be filed with the Police Department. Should a police detail be necessary, payment for same must be made to the Town Treasurer's office prior to the date of sale.
