Revised Water Restriction Notice

Effective Immediately

The Town of Rockport Public Works Commissioners has revised the mandatory water restrictions on outdoor water usage that went into effect on May 27, 2019. Effective immediately, all those using town water for outdoor water uses shall now follow the mandatory restriction as follows:

- The use of garden sprinkler systems and soaker hoses that use Town water is prohibited at all times while these water restrictions are in effect.
- The use of a hand held garden hose is allowed for a maximum period of 1 hour per day for all outdoor water uses, including watering of lawns & gardens, filling of swimming pools, washing of cars & houses and for other various residential and business uses. Only 1 hour of outdoor watering between the hours of 7AM and 9 AM or between the hours of 5 PM and 8 PM is allowed.
- Residents using well water for outdoor watering purposes must register with the Department of Public Works and display a sign on their property visible to the street that indicates well water is being used for watering purposes.
