Said permittee shall conform to the statutes and ordinances of the Town of Rockport, approved by the Director of Public Works, as security for restoring such street to a condition satisfactory to the Director, and for keeping the cut section of the street in a satisfactory condition for six (6) months. Said cut section shall be backfilled in ten (10) inch layers for proper compaction and surfaced with temporary patch. After proper settlement, all temporary patch shall be removed, edges of excavation cut back six (6) inches, and entire cut section surfaced with two (2) layers of bituminous concrete, Type 1 mix, for all bituminous concrete roads. All other streets and sidewalks shall be surfaced with material of existing type.

Said permittee shall be responsible for maintaining proper barriers and signs during the whole time the street is opened or obstructed. During time of snow or ice conditions during progress of work, the permittee shall keep the roadway well sanded to a point not less than two hundred feet beyond the limits of the barriers and signs. All signs, steel street plates, and materials will be on site prior to any street excavation. Flowable fill must be used on Granite Street, Broadway, Mt. Pleasant Street and Route 127A.

No painting, sidewalk work or dumpsters shall be permitted on Main Street (beginning on Beach Street by Poole's Corner), Dock Square, lower Mt. Pleasant Street (to Atlantic Avenue) and Broadway between Memorial Day weekend and September 1<sup>st</sup> for reasons of safety due to the high pedestrian traffic. Any exception will be at the sole discretion of the Director of Public Works.

All work shall be satisfactory to the Director of Public Works.
